What is Block Watch?

A group of dedicated residents who join together to place more “eyes and ears” in their neighborhood.

Why should I join?

It works. With everyone’s busy lives we are often away from home. This allows neighbors to watch other homes and report crime and suspicious activity to police.

How do I join?

Speak with your neighbors and determine their interest. Select an individual to act as “Block Captain” who will coordinate the program. Establish a date and time for the first meeting. A representative from the Police Department will assist in holding the meeting at the Police Department or in your neighborhood.

What are the requirements after the Program is started?

- Sign up for Robbinsdale Crime Alerts
- Report suspicious activity by calling **911**
- Maintain communication between neighbors
- Hold periodic meetings with members
- Be active in National Night Out
- Be active with Robbinsdale Crime Prevention Association
