Pursuant to Robbinsdale City Code Section 910.47 a permit is required for recreational fires for in ground fire pits and portable self-contained units:

- ✓ A recreational fire permit is required by the City of Robbinsdale.
- ✓ Application for recreational fire permit must include a site drawing identifying distances to garages, houses, sheds, fences, decks, roofs, combustible materials and <u>all</u> property lines.
- ✓ All non-recreational fires shall be considered "open burning" and are not allowed in the City of Robbinsdale.

requiren	nents:
	Recreational fires must be on private property.
	All recreational fires must be a minimum of $\underline{10}$ feet from \underline{all} property lines. **
	The person in charge of the recreational fire must be age 18 years or older and a resident of the permit
	address, and shall be present for the duration of the fire. Before leaving the site, the person in charge
	shall completely extinguish the fire.
	ONLY CLEAN, DRY FIREWOOD SHALL BE USED.
	Oils, rubber, shingles, painted or treated lumber, leaves, trash or garbage shall not be
	burned or used as starting materials. Burning construction material is not allowed.
	Flames shall not exceed 2 feet above base of fire.
	The prevailing wind at the time of the fire shall not exceed 5 mph and shall not direct smoke toward nearby residences.
	Fire extinguishment aids shall be immediately accessible, i.e., garden hose, shovel, sand, fire extinguisher.
	Recreational fires shall not start before 9:00 a.m. and must be extinguished by 11:00 p.m.
	Recreational fires are limited to 5 hours in duration and limited to no more than 5 hours in any
	24 hour period.
	The recreational fire permit must be kept at the permit address and applicant shall produce the permit
	when requested to do so by a Fire Official or a Police Officer.
In grou	nd fire pits are limited to the following conditions – please initial:
	A fire pit shall be constructed with a maximum diameter of three feet and minimum depth of one foot.
	The outer ring shall be constructed with a non-combustible material.
	In ground recreational fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure (i.e., garages,
	houses, sheds), fences, decks, roofs, or combustible materials.
Portabl	e self-contained units are limited to the following conditions – please initial:
	A portable self-contained unit shall be constructed with a maximum diameter of three feet and
	minimum depth of one foot, and shall have a spark arresting screen and cover for containment of the
	fire.
	Recreational fires in a portable unit shall not be conducted within 15 feet of a structure (i.e.,
	garages, houses, sheds), fences, decks, roofs, or combustible materials. Chiminea and ceramic/clay
	units are prohibited.

- ✓ The Fire Chief or designee, or any Police Officer, is authorized to require that recreational fires be immediately discontinued if any recreational fire requirement is violated, or if the Fire Chief, or designee, or Police Officer determines that the fire constitutes a hazardous condition. Any person or persons who fail to comply with these conditions shall be in violation of the above regulation and permit will be revoked. (\$50.00 reinstatement fee if permit is revoked.) A citation for violation of city ordinances may also be issued.
- ✓ Recreational fires are not allowed when the DNR (Minnesota Department of Natural Resources), www.dnr.state.mn.us (wildfire danger) or the Robbinsdale Fire Department has declared a burning ban, or air quality alert declared by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (www.pca.state.mn.us) 651-297-1630.
- ✓ Observation of these requirements does not release persons of any liability for any loss or damages that may result from a recreational fire.
